

Gakushu Shoureihi Scholarship
Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology 2021
(Program for promoting employment for foreign students)

Who Can Apply:

Privately-funded international students enrolled in Kumamoto University as regular students as of April 2021
("Student" status on resident card)

Eligibility: Person who corresponds to all of following criterias

- ① Those who have GPA of 2.30/ 3.00 scale or higher in the previous academic year and are expected to maintain it even during the payment period. (Details of calculation method etc. will be described in the application guidelines.) If it can not be expressed by the grade evaluation coefficient, it should be a person who is recognized as excellent student in particular with a grade evaluation coefficient of 2.30 or more.
- ② Person who corresponds to language ability level of one of the followings
A: Japanese language ability
Those who passed the N2 level or higher in the Japanese Language Proficiency Test conducted by the Japan Foundation and Japan Educational Exchanges and Services. Those who have scores of 200 or higher on Japanese Proficiency Test for the Japan Study Abroad Examination conducted by the organization or those who have language proficiency levels above which the organization separately recognizes.
B: English language ability
Those who are recognized as B2 or higher in CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, teaching, assessment)
- ③ Being a person who is willing to cooperate in the survey on the course situation conducted through the university by the organization, after receiving the scholarship.
- ④ Ensure that the average monthly allowance is 90,000 yen or less (not including admission fee, tuition, etc.).
- ⑤ The annual income of dependents living in Japan is less than 5 million yen.
- ⑥ Those who have not received other scholarships and/or other benefits that are restricted from being paid concurrently with this scholarship.
- ⑦ Those who have not be supported by JASSO's overseas study support system.
- ⑧ Participants in Kumamoto University CDP+K Program 2021 (Persons who will apply for participation in the programs to the conducted by CDP Office and take lectures based on the program in 2021: You must submit "Application for Kumamoto University CDP+K Program 2021")

Contents of Payment:

Scholarship monthly stipend: 48,000 yen

Period of payment: April, 2021 – March, 2022 (for 12 months)

On-Campus Selection: Yes (Zoom Interview by CDP will be held on Monday, April 19 – Wednesday, April 21)

***For interviews, please visit CDP Office (1st floor of General Education Building C) by the submission deadline (April 13, 2021) directly and request for the preferred date and time.**

Documents to be Submitted:

(1) Application form (Please check with your academic affairs staff about the grade evaluation factor column)

(2) Copy of Japan Post Bank account bankbook information page

*To receive scholarship, you need "Japan Post Bank ordinary savings" account. Please have your Kana name printed on the bankbook when open your account.

(3) Copies of residence card (both sides)

(4) Documents to prove that the above condition **Eligibility** ② is satisfied

How to submit documents:

1: For the application form, first enter the data other than the grade evaluation coefficient in the Excel data.

2: The grade evaluation coefficient will be filled in after confirmation by the academic affairs department to which you belong, so please take the printed application form to your academic affairs department and request it.

3: When all the documents are ready, convert all the documents to PDF data and submit it by the deadline.

- To prevent the spread of new coronavirus infections, application documents will be submitted as PDF data.
- This scholarship is required to be registered in the "Kumamoto University CDP+K Program 2021", attend a Japanese language education program and career seminar, and participate in an internship. Please note that scholarships may be suspended depending on the course status.
- Students who have become nominees must sign at CDP Office every month after April to confirm your enrollment. In addition, students who have become nominees must submit a set of application documents in paper form by the designated date. We will contact the target students again.
